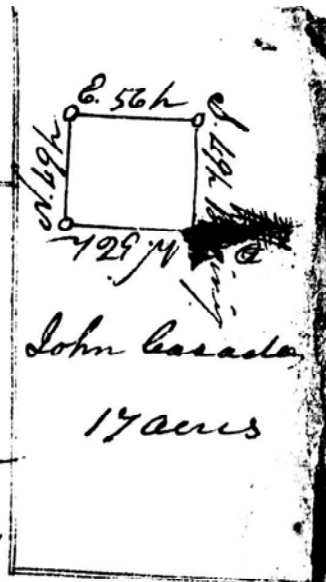

 Entered November 6th 1829 I have surveyed
 a tract of Land for John Casada, lying on
 the west side of French Broad river between
 Burnetts Mill creek and its forks joining William
 Hawkins land on the North side Eve Smiths on the
 East side and Jeps Burnetts land including the head
 of a small branch beginning on a Black oak
 William Hawkins corner on Jeps Burnetts line
 on a ridge as running west fifty five poles to a
 Hickory along Jeps Burnetts line thence North forty
 nine poles along Eve Smiths line to a stake
 thence East fifty five poles to a stake along
 said Casadas line thence South ^{forty nine poles} to the Beginning
